### Instructions for submission of Abstract

- Abstract (not exceeding 100 words) in English should be submitted electronically (via email) on or before October 30, 2017. The Abstract must contain the following information: Names of author(s), their institutional/ organizational affiliation, addresses (postal and email), and mobile/ landline phone numbers. Only electronic submission in the form of a word file sent as an e-mail attachment will be accepted. The abstracts should be mailed to the Conference Convener. Decision on Abstract will be intimated via email by November 10, 2017.
- Up to 4 keywords should be enlisted below the abstract.

- Kindly note that all the submissions should be the original work of the Author(s), and should not have been published anywhere before or is not under consideration in any journal.
- Guidelines for Full Paper (Manuscript) submission will be provided after the acceptance of Abstract.
- The full paper (including abstract & references) should not exceed a limit of 3,000 words.
- All papers presented in the conference will be published in an edited book (with ISBN) by SPRE, after it has been reviewed.
- No TA/DA will be paid for attending the conference.
